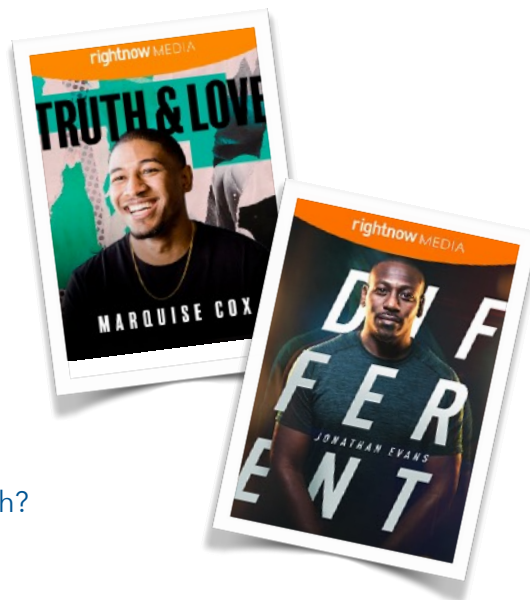

Retreat Location: Awanita Valley Christian Retreat - Marietta, SC - www.awanita.org

Friday: **Meet at the Youth House at 10:00am**, lunch on the road, paintball at Red Fox in Woodruff, arrival at Awanita, dinner, worship and small group Bible study, evening activity/hang-time

Saturday: All Day at Awanita - breakfast, quiet time, small groups, low ropes course, lunch, afternoon activities including horseback riding, Hummer trail rides, basketball, paddle boats and other activities, dinner, worship, small groups and bonfire.

Sunday: Breakfast, quiet time, small groups, worship, departure for home (lunch on the way home). We should arrive home around 3:00pm.

Packing List: Paper Bible, towels, sheets/blanket for a twin or sleeping bag, pillow, modest clothing for three days (extra clothing/shoes in case you get dirty), toiletries, coat and rain jacket (check the weather). Phones/electronics can be brought on the trip, but will be collected upon arrival at camp and returned as we head home. There is nearly zero cell service or wifi at Awanita.
